


A fair share for the regions

Better access to childcare, health & aged care

We deserve access to quality services in our towns. As part of our historic investment in regional Australia, the LNP will invest in better access to childcare services, train more doctors and invest in building more aged care facilities.

Affordable & reliable energy

Cost of living relief
