



### **Our plan to Get Australia Back on Track**

#### A fair share for the regions

An LNP Government will deliver guaranteed funding for regional, rural and remote Australia through a new dedicated \$20 billion fund to tackle local challenges like fixing local roads, better access to local services and create a strong and sustainable future for our towns.

#### Better access to childcare. health & aged care

We deserve access to quality services in our towns. As part of our historic investment in regional Australia, the LNP will invest in better access to childcare services, train more doctors and invest in building more aged care facilities.

#### Affordable & reliable energy

The LNP will unlock our massive reserves of Australian gas to drive down prices, and invest in a balanced, long-term energy plan that includes safe, clean and reliable nuclear energy. Our energy plan will be 44% cheaper than Labor's and make sure regional Australia doesn't become littered with industrial wind turbines and solar panels.

#### **Cost of living relief**
